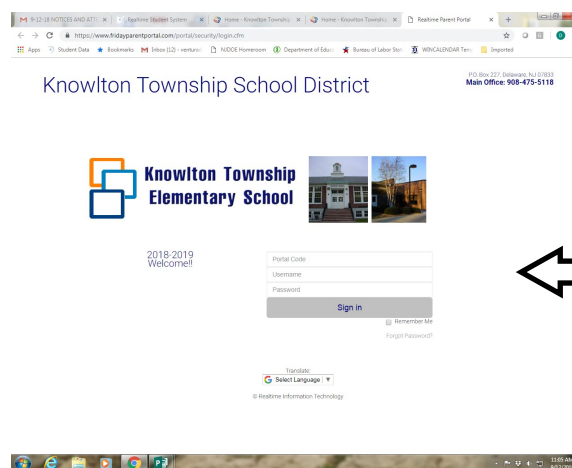

Like This


AUTHOR VISIT
