Students are invited to dress in costumes and parade with their classes in the back of the school on the walking path beginning at 2 pm (weather permitting). Family members may view the parade in designated areas along the walking path. *****ALL PARENTS MUST SIGN IN AT THE TABLE LOCATED AT THE WEST WING GATE BEFORE ENTERING THE WALKING PATH AREA TO VIEW THE PARADE.**

Please note:

- Students should not wear costumes to school. They should bring costumes with their name and teacher's name clearly marked.
- Costumes depicting any violence or horror as seen in the movies, on the news, or in comics are not permitted.
- Weapons of any kind, including metal, plastic, wood and cardboard are not permitted.
- Costumes should reflect age appropriate characters.

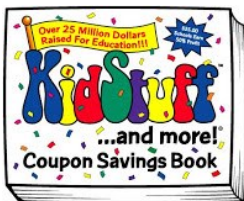

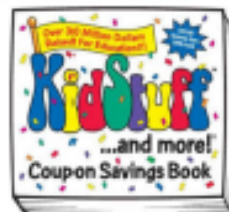
