## School Picture Make Ups Tuesday, November 13!

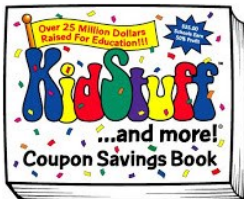

Are your students fueled up with a balanced breakfast and ready to learn when they start their day at school every morning? Unfortunately, many children are skipping breakfast and aren't ready to learn when the bell rings. Students skip breakfast for a variety of reasons. Regardless of the reason, hungry students do not learn well!

We are happy to offer breakfast to the students of Knowlton Township Elementary School as part of the school breakfast program. This breakfast is available daily for all students.

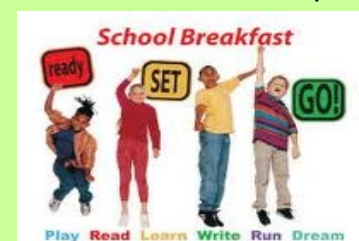
Breakfast is important to all students in the classroom. Research has proven that students who enjoy a nutritious breakfast have better test scores and are more attentive in class.

Breakfast will be \$1.50 for students. Those who currently qualify for a reduced-price lunch, also qualify for a reduce-priced breakfast at a cost of \$.30. Eligible free lunch students are also entitled to a free breakfast.

Breakfast will be offered daily in the office from 8:30 – 8:45 am. Students arriving on buses should let their bus driver know that they are attending the breakfast program so they may disembark upon arrival at the school. Breakfast will be served in a grab and go manner. The cafeteria staff will be offering a variety of foods to entice your students to start their day fueled up! Please consult your menu for the daily selections. Students may pay using their meal account or with cash.

A child who comes to school hungry has great difficulty concentrating in anything other than their hunger. We are pleased to provide breakfast as an option to all students in Knowlton Township Elementary School.
