For those who currently qualify for reduced price lunch the cost is .30 cents.

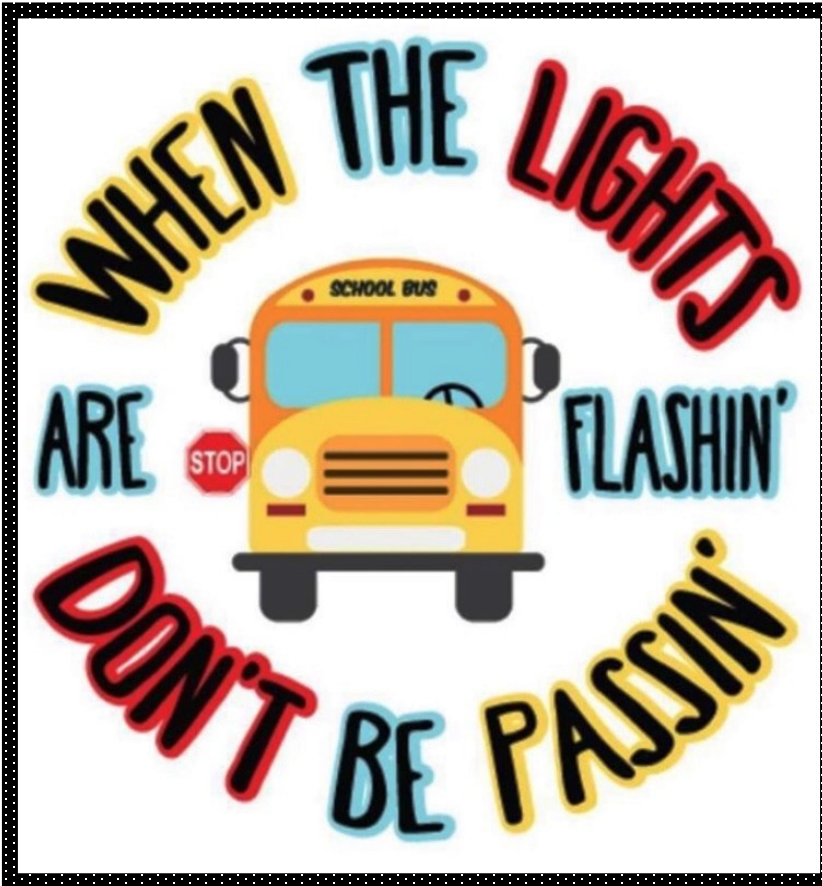
Eligible free lunch students are also entitled to free breakfast.
