
#### Eligibility criteria:

- Be an expert in the field who inspires students of all backgrounds and abilities to learn
- Actively collaborates with colleagues, students, and families to create a strong culture of respect and success
- Demonstrate leadership and innovation in educational activities at the school, district, and/or state and
  national levels that take place both within and outside the school setting.
- Have the respect and admiration of students, parents, and colleagues
- Demonstrate poise, eloquence, and the ability to maintain a demanding schedule
- Have not earned the title of Teacher of the Year or Educational Services Professional of the year for the past five (5) years
