

#### TREX Recycling Update...

- KTES's total recycling amount for the month of November was 282 pounds of plastic. So far we have recycled 539 pounds since September!
- We are getting some plastic in that can NOT be recycled. Here are some examples of plastics Trex CAN recycle:
  - Grocery bags Bread bags Case overwrap Dry cleaning bags Newspaper sleeves Ice Bags Wood pellet bags Ziploc and other reclosable bags Produce bags (that you put produce in at the grocery store) Bubble wrap Salt bags Cereal bags
