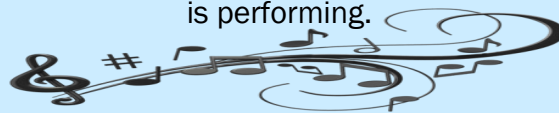
Annual Holiday Shoppe

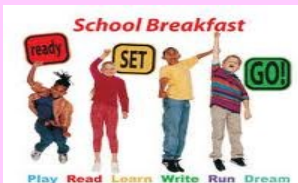

TREX Recycling Update...

- KTES's total recycling amount for the month of November was 282 pounds of plastic. So far we have recycled 539 pounds since September!
- We are getting some plastic in that can NOT be recycled. Here are some examples of plastics Trex CAN recycle:
 - Grocery bags
 - Bread bags
 - Case overwrap
 - Dry cleaning bags
 - Newspaper sleeves
 - Ice Bags
 - Wood pellet bags
 - Ziploc and other reclosable bags
 - Produce bags (that you put produce in at the grocery store)
 - Bubble wrap
 - Salt bags
 - Cereal bags
