

## Important Information from Our School Nurse Concerning GERMS & LICE...

Dear Parents,

Holiday breaks are a great time to visit friends and family....but it's also a great opportunity to share germs and lice too! Please remind your child to wash his/her hands frequently, and encourage all your friends and family members to cover their coughs. Also, <u>PLEASE CHECK</u> <u>YOUR CHILD'S HEAD FOR HEAD LICE AND NITS BEFORE RETURNING TO SCHOOL</u> <u>AFTER BREAK</u>. If your child is going to share a sleeping space with others, do a quick head check before bed to make sure everyone is lice-free. It will only take a few minutes, and it will save you a LOT of time and energy later on!

As a reminder, if you find head lice, you must notify the school health office and you should also notify the parents of your child's friends with whom they've had recent contact. Your child's name will not be shared, but it helps me keep track of how many cases there are in each grade and class and where we need to focus our prevention efforts. I will also recheck your child when they return to school following treatment, but I have to know about cases of lice in order to do this! Please encourage other Knowlton parents to report cases of known lice as well. This is not just a school issue—it is a community issue, and we all need to work together to prevent the spread of lice.


