MARCH MADNESS

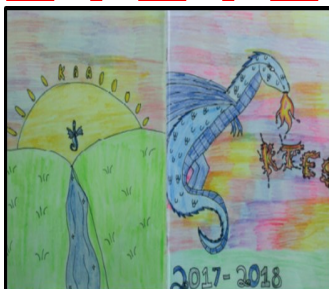

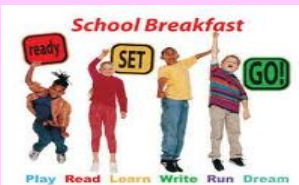

- **Yogurt Parfaits will be served for breakfast on Tuesdays and Thursdays.**



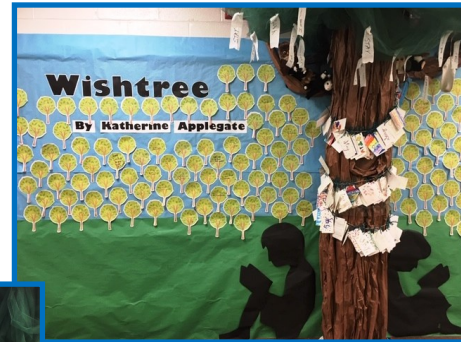

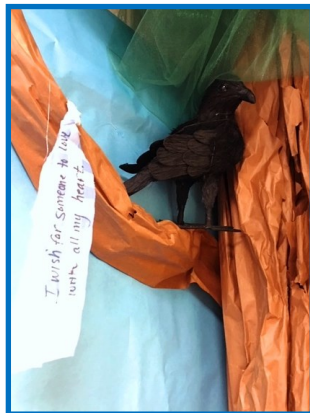

REGISTRATION FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR

Knowlton Twp. Elementary Preschool Program We are now accepting registrations for our Preschool Program for fall 2019. Children must be 4 years old by October 1, 2019 and must be toilet trained. The program runs Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 11:00 am when school is in session. Transportation for this program is not provided. Attention Parents of Future Kindergarten Students: Knowlton Twp. Elementary School is planning for the 2019-2020 school year. At this time we would like to identify as many children as possible who will be eligible for Kindergarten in September 2019. To be eligible for kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old by October 1, 2019. 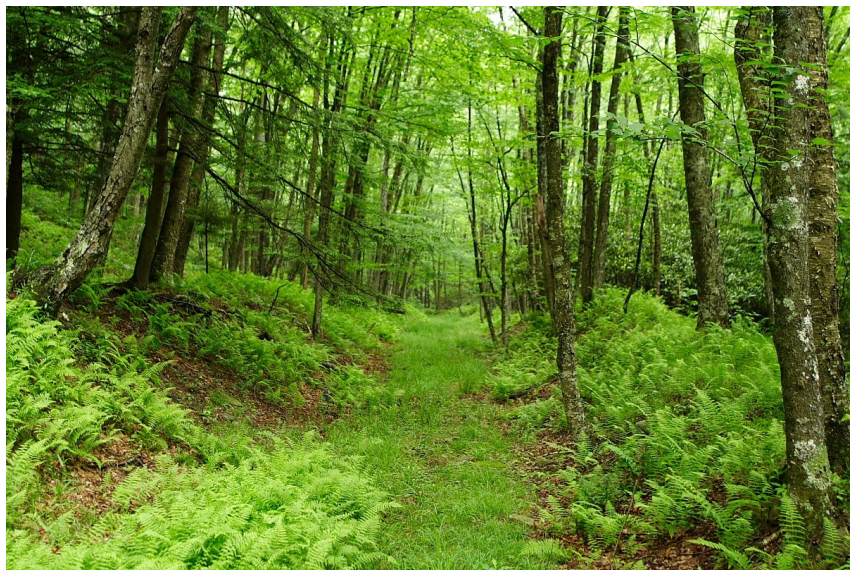
