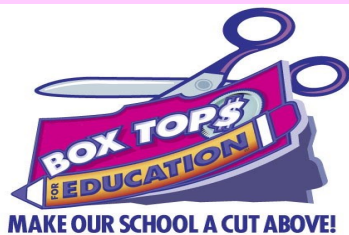

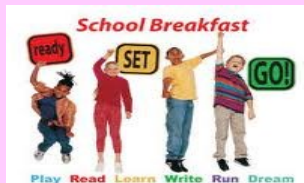

- **Yogurt Parfaits will be served for breakfast on Tuesdays and Thursdays.**

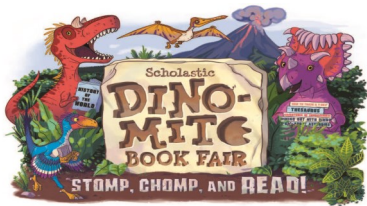
REGARDING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR:

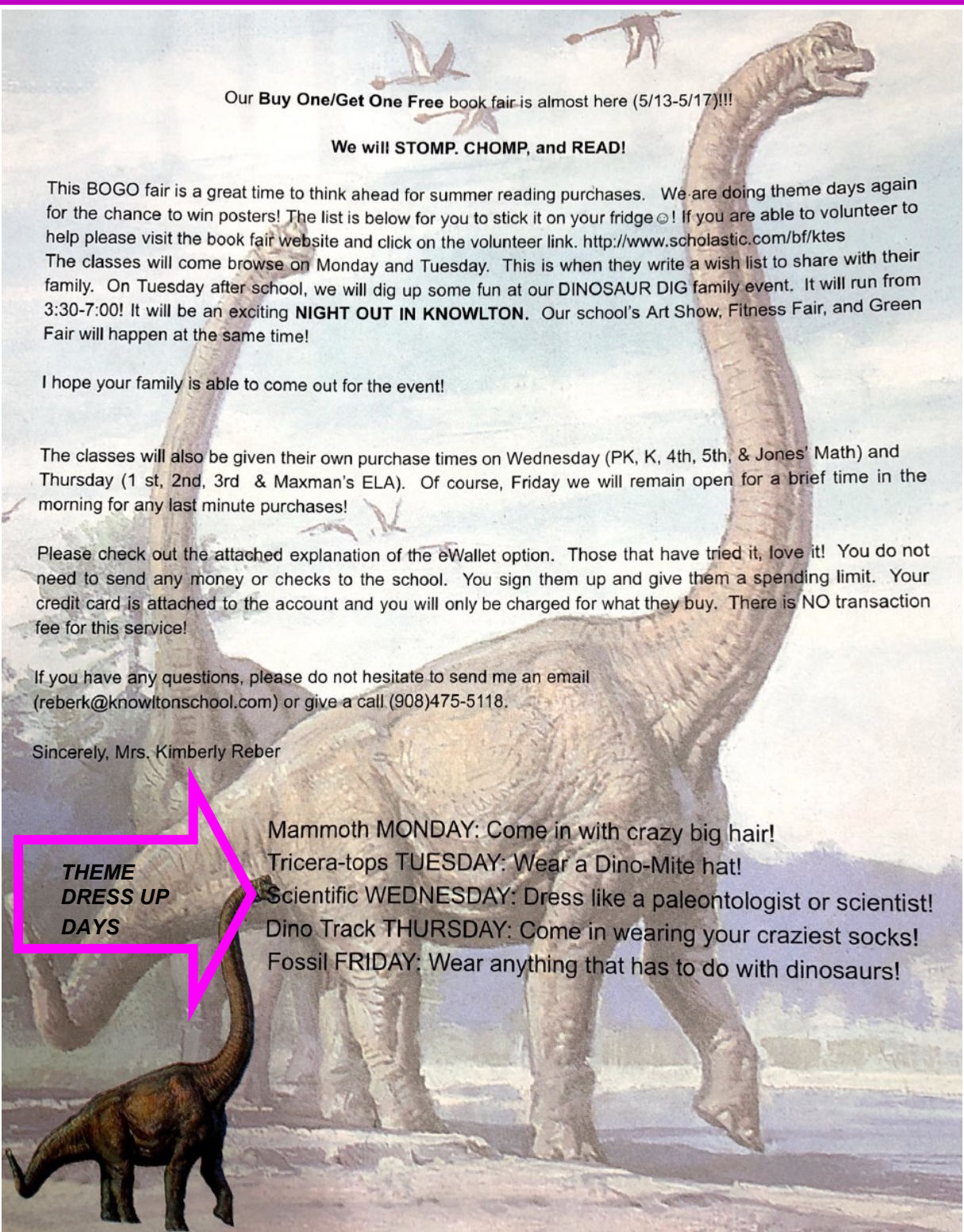

Attention Parents of Future Kindergarten Students:

Knowlton Twp. Elementary School is planning for the 2019-2020 school year. At this time we would like to identify as many children as possible who will be eligible for Kindergarten in September 2019.

To be eligible for kindergarten, a child must be 5 years old by October 1, 2019. 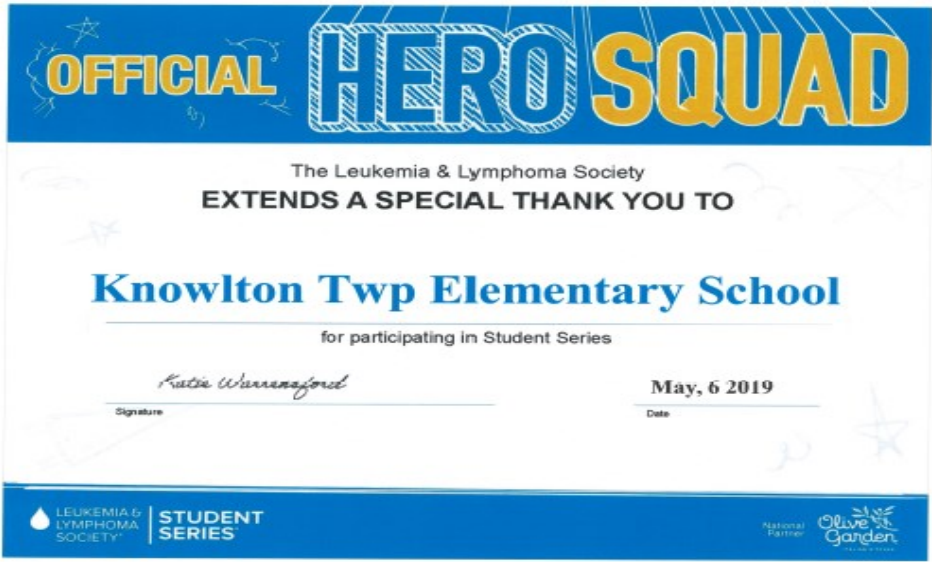

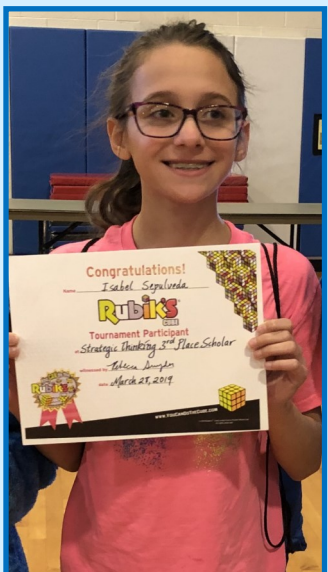
