The week before the fair, October 7-11th, we will be holding a coin race to see which classes will be able to choose the books we add to the library from our fair. We will be running the contest Monday through Friday. The grade levels with the most money raised will be awarded extra time to come to the fair to "library shop" with Mrs. Reber.

Here is how the contest will work:

- Monday, October 7th is "Penny Day"- Bring in your pennies to put in your grade level's coin jar.
- Tuesday, October 8th is "Nickel Day"- Bring your dimes in to add to the pennies in the grade level coin jar.
