Knowlton Elementary will have a Halloween Parade on October 31st.

Students are invited to dress in costumes and parade with their classes in the back of the school on the walking path beginning at 2 pm (weather permitting). Family members may view the parade in designated areas along the walking path. ***ALL PARENTS MUST SIGN IN AT THE TABLE LOCATED AT THE WEST WING GATE BEFORE ENTERING THE WALKING PATH AREA TO VIEW THE PARADE.

Please note:

- Students should not wear costumes to school. They should bring costumes with their name and teacher's name clearly marked.
- Costumes depicting any violence or horror as seen in the movies, on the news, or in comics are not permitted.
- Weapons of any kind, including metal, plastic, wood and cardboard are not permitted.
- Costumes should reflect age appropriate characters.

In order to help ensure the safety and well-being of all our students and staff members, please follow the procedures will be followed: 1)Parents/Guardians can watch the parade along the walking path, 2) The parade will begin promptly at 2 pm, and students will walk by grade level, 3) Fall classroom celebrations will occur after the parade. Only those parents who are assisting with classroom celebrations will be permitted into the building. Still experiencing difficulties in getting on the Parent Portal? If you are getting a message regarding "no district" detected, try this...

- Go up to your browser and highlight "no district" to the end, delete that, and then type in knowlton and hit enter.
 The parent portal login page should now appear asking for your portal code, user name & password.
- If that does not work, go to the school website,
 www.knowltonschool.com and click on the "For Parents"
 Tab, Resources, then Parent Portal. The parent portal login
 page should now appear asking for your portal code, user
 name & password. Do Not Click on the Parent Portal Icon
 the first time you are accessing the portal. Once you
 have successfully accessed the portal the Parent Portal
 Icon Tab should work correctly.
- Should you still have trouble, please call the main office and we will try to help you gain access.

Regarding Student Lunch Accounts:

How to receive credit for your Box Top app submissions:

- From the app home screen, tap on the earnings summary at the top, and then select "My Eearnings.
- When the list of your submissions appears, tap on one of the submissions to open it.
- On the next screen tap on the 3 vertical dots at the top right (first screenshot shown below).
- Choose "Give Credit" (middle screenshot shown below).
- A blank box appears. Type your teacher's <u>last name</u> in the box and save it.
- Credit can be given to past earnings by following these steps.
- Once a name is entered and saved, it should automatically assign to future earnings.







Reminders for Box Top labels:

- <u>Continue clipping Box Top labels</u>. They are still valid and still appear on many products.
- <u>Do not</u> submit expired Box Top labels. They don't count and will be discarded.
- Please <u>trim</u> your Box Top labels. This is a huge help to the coordinators that prepare them for shipping.
- Bring in your Box Top labels in a bag or envelope with your teacher's name on it so that
 your class receives proper credit.




From Mrs. Acker, Our School Nurse:

How exposure to **blue light** affects your brain and body

BY DISRUPTING MELATONIN, SMARTPHONE LIGHT RUINS SLEEP SCHEDULES. THIS LEADS TO ALL KINDS OF HEALTH PROBLEMS:

The disruption to your sleep schedule might leave you distracted and impair your **MEMORY** the next day.



A poor night's sleep caused by smartphone light can make it HARDER TO LEARN.



Over the long term, not getting enough sleep can lead to **NEUROTOXIN** buildup that makes it even harder for you to get good sleep.



People whose melatonin levels are suppressed and whose body clocks are thrown off by light exposure are more prone to **DEPRESSION**.



By disrupting melatonin and sleep, smartphone light can also mess with the hormones that control hunger, potentially increasing **OBESITY RISK**.

There's some evidence that blue light could damage our vision by harming the **RETINA** over time — though more research is needed.



Researchers are investigating whether or not blue light could lead to CATARACTS.





There's a connection between light exposure at night and the disturbed sleep that come with it and an increased risk of breast and prostate CANCERS.
